USE OF THE MAIN AREA

The main area will be cleared for preparation, for at least 3 hours after the last class of each day. Additionally the area will be open 2 hours before the competition.

DQHA FUTURITY / MATURITY

Admitted are only American Quarter Horses, whose sire is paid into the SSA(the year prior to the actual breeding), as well as foals from auctioned breeding. From year 2011, all foals need to be nominated for the DQHA Futurity/Maturity classes at the DQHA office. A foal born in 2013 is only admitted, when the sire is nominated into the SSA 2011 and the foal is nominated into the Futurity. Whether the stallion is paid in or not, you can find out at the DQHA office or at www.dqha.de.

The exhibitor and owner of the horse (as per Certificate of Registration/Registration Application) needs to be a member of the DQHA. Notice: The DQHA membership of the owner needs to be in accordance with the AQHA membership on top of the AQHA Certificate of registration/Registration Application. That means: for potential partnerships, trainings stables, owners associations etcetera, the DQHA membership needs to be supplemented.

This is possible for the amount of an family membership (now 34,- Euro), when at least one person is already an official DQHA Main member of this partnership, trainings stable, owner association etcetera.

The “family membership” request needs to be signed by one approved signee.

If it is not possible for the owner to sign the declaration of entry right before the start, it is possible, to be registered as a “licensed owner” for a fee of 123 Euro.

The won price money will be captured in a “Leading-summary” according to the Memberships/ Membership numbers. The breeders reward is only for breeders, which are DQHA members at that moment.

When you nominate a foal out of IMPRESSIVE bred horses for the Futurity/Maturity, the owner must add an AQHA validated HYPP N/N proof to the nomination forms, because otherwise a participation is not possible.

For enrolling in Weanling classes, you also need to consider the following: classes with more than 12 foals will be divided. If the foal is not yet AQHA registered, alternatively, a copy of the Registration Application and a copy of the Certificate of Registration of Sire and Dam need to be handed in.

The exact date of birth must be filled in. If the owner has a Futurity/Maturity free start voucher available, a clear notice on top of the nomination is necessary and the original voucher needs to be attached.

No broodmare is allowed to be in the showpen during Weanling classes, neither in the showpen nor the marked off preparation area.

Incomplete Futurity/Maturity Nominations are sent back unprocessed.

DQHA reserves the right, to carry out Futurity/Maturity classes, if necessary class in class with the corresponding AQHA discipline.

For DQHA Futurity/Maturity classes, DQHA set of rules from the official rulebook 2013 are applied.

No Post-nominations are possible for DQHA Futurity/Maturity classes.

Evaluation of Futurity/Maturity classes and Champion of Champions will be carried out according to the AQHA World Show point system. In scored classes, scores are added, in placed classes points are awarded according to the AQHA World Show system per placement and will be added thereupon. In a validation with 5 judges, the highest and the lowest score will be removed.

SHOW REGULATIONS:

For the execution of this competition, regulations of the current AQHA/DQHA set of rules 2013, as well as the enclosed instructions apply:

1. Nominations can only be accepted if:

- nomination forms are completely filled out and arrive in time (postmark is decisive).

- entry fees and dues in full are enclosed and the applicant is in possession of the respective memberships.

Please add a copy of your AQHA-membership card and respectively Amateur, Youth or Novice card 2013, or give a hint, that it needs to be purchased on-site. A copy of the Certificate of Registration respectively a copy of the registration application for foals which are not yet registered and a copy of sires & dam certificate of registration needs to be handed in. The exact date of birth has to be filled in.

2. By submitting the nomination form, the exhibitor/horse owner accepts the announcement and valid registrations.
3. The organizer reserves the right, to change announcement and schedule till nomination deadline, to postpone the show or to cancel the event with return of nomination fees, as far as special circumstances necessitate that.
4. There is no contractual relationship between the organizer on the one side and visitors, horse owners and participants on the other side. Moreover, any liability for theft and injuries of man and animal is excluded. Especially, participants are not assistants as defined by §278 and §831 German Civil Code. Every horse owner and participant, as well as their companions and visitors, submits with nomination respectively entry of the showground to the regulations and explanations of the organizer and accepts the rules of AQHA and DQHA.
5. The organizer is not liable for late or lost mail.
6. Each horse needs to be covered by liability insurance. Horses have to be free of contagious diseases respectively come from a infection-free population. All of them need to be vaccinated for the time of competition and therefore be immunized against Influenza. The owner have to proof the vaccination status anytime trough presentation of the documents (equine passport with vaccination record)especially to the show-office.
7. Upon presentation of a medical certificate before the show, the showmanagement can refund half of the entry fees. Cattle and office charge are not refunded. Stall money will only be refunded, if the reserved stall can be sub-leased further (that means no free stalls are available at that moment).
8. At the beginning, each participant gets a nomination confirmation with the actual schedule. The exhibitor is responsible for his punctual arrival at start time. The organizer has the right to start the competition 30 minutes before the scheduled time.
9. **If the Select classes have less than 3 nominations at closure time, class will be cancelled and integrated into Amateur classes.**
10. Dogs on the showground have to be kept at a leash. Loose dogs get captured and can be redeemed at the show office (costs 100,- Euro).
11. It is not allowed on the showground, to ride or lunge without a valid starting number. The whole area, especially preparation area, will be checked on unsporting behavior (compare set of rules §441).
12. To improve fairness towards our horse partner, official staff will be equipped with cameras, to record critical situations. Those short-takes will be consulted to clarify the actual situation. They are not meant for a third person. In case of unsporting behavior, short-takes can be used as a proof in front of an arbitral court. The organizer also reserves the right to consult images of third parties. The participant has no right to the recordings. With his entry, the participants accept these measures to improve fairness in the equestrian sport.
13. With the entry of the nomination form, the participant declares his acceptance to be photographed or filmed at the event and that the pictures can be published.
14. Photographers and Videocompanys which are commissioned for the event, have exclusive rights. No other Photographer may offer pictures of the event for sale. Private photographing and filming is allowed.
15. Disbursement of prizes and reimbursement
The host of the event has the right to deduct any unpaid obligations of participants. This is valid for the withholding tax of § 50a Abs. 4 EstG for international horse owners as well. After the deduction of the sales tax of the prize, the following tax deduction is due: up to 250 € 0 %, up to 500 € 10 %, up to 1.000 € 15 %, more than 1.000 € 20%; plus 5,5 % solidarity surcharge on the tax-deductible amount (expenses for the competition will be credited). The tax deduction has to be verified on request. International horse owners, which are exempt of tax deduction, may hand-in a notice of non-liability for taxes with their nomination form. This is due until the first day of the event latest. Participants are responsible for the correct and full details on their nomination.

New regulations as off 2011:

In the preparation area, only equipment from the official AQHA/DQHA rulebook 2013 is allowed. Exceptions: Mouth shutter, gliding ring martingale combined with a Snaffle Bit, tendon boots, bandages and fetlock boots.

INTERNATIONAL DQHA CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR AMERICAN QUARTER HORSES

In Open classes, the title is awarded to the horse. In Amateur, Select and Youth classes the title is awarded to the horse/rider combination.

For evaluating the international DQHA champion, AQHA-Shows 1-4 are equally assessed. Thereby the results of those particular shows are marked according to the point system of the AQHA World Show. That means in placed classes, points are awarded and added for the particular positions. In scored classes, scores are added. (scored classes: Western Riding, Reining, Working Cowhorse, Trail, Cutting. Placed classes: Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, Showmanship at Halter, Hunter under Saddle, Hunt Seat Equitation, Hunter Hack, Longe Line, Halter). If there is a tie, the respective tie-judge, who will be announced in advance for each class, decides.

1. In the classification, all participants of the Q13 are included, when they meet the criteria for the AQHA-show and at the same time the horse owner is a member of the DQHA. In Amateur/Youth classes, a membership of the exhibitor is needed, according to the tribute.
2. Int. DQHA Champion can only become a horse /Horse/Rider combination, which has been started in Show 1/2 as well as Show 3/4. Three starters in one class are compulsory.
3. If a participant does not want to be assessed for the DQHA championship of American Quarter Horses, he has to take note of it specifically on the nomination form or remark it at the show office.

4. With less than 3 participants in one class, no Int. DQHA Champion of American Quarter Horses will be determined.
5. In Novice-classes, no Int. DQHA Champion of American Quarter Horses will be determined.
6. Following doping regulations apply:

FORBIDDEN MEDICATION AND DOPING

By signing the entry form, each exhibitor and horse owner agrees on a medication/drug testing by urine or blood sample on his horse. Every horse entered in the Futurity/Maturity of the International DQHA Championship and also the German Championship Reining can be called to a doping test. Therefore the anti-doping and medication rules in equestrian sports of the FN are valid and applied. (the rules may be found at www.pferd-aktuell.de)

This means, in case of a detection of violation of the medication- and doping regulations, all results of the horse at that particular competition are annulled and as a consequence all titles, medals, prizes and points are deprived.

The organizer also reserves the right to take further disciplinary action/sanctions against that horse-rider combination, or the horse owner.

For the German Championship Reining, instructions from FN apply, also the execution of action fall to the FN.

CLIPPING

We point out that the show veterinarians have the authority to interpret the German animal protection law and apply that clipped horses, especially horses with no whiskers at the mouth and nostrils, can be excluded from further participation. The host takes no responsibility in this case or any liability or damages.

GERMAN CHAMPIONSHIP REINING

Admitted are only riders, who qualified previously. Those participants are announced from the FN and published under www.DQHA.de.

There are specific provisions / rules for the German Championship Reining in 2012 of the German Olympic Equestrian Committee e. V. (DOKR) of the German Equestrian Federation (FN), which can be viewed under www.DQHA.de.

Every horse participating in the German Championship has to pass a Vet-Check previous to the event. The Vet-Check will take place on Saturday, 19.10.2013 at 11 o'clock am. Participants who refuse to attend will be disqualified immediately.

Doping/Medication rules DM Reining

The rules of the FN, LPO jurisdiction (performance regulations) of the FN in conjunction with the FN anti-doping and medication control rules for the equestrian-ADMR count in the current version.

NSBA FUTURITY

1. Western Pleasure and Hunter under Saddle Futurity: Qualified are all 3 – 6 year old offspring of the NSBA-Futurity paid in stallions (List was published in the quarter horse journal and on www.nsba-germany.de)
2. Longe Line Futurity: Qualified are all 1-2 year old offspring of paid in stallions.
3. Exhibitor and owner of the participating horses have to be members of the NSBA of Germany.
4. Participating horses need to be born in Europe.
5. The host is NSBA of Germany e.V. and they are responsible for the rules.

NRCHA USA CLASSES

It will be ridden and judged according to the valid NRCHA USA rulebook 2013.

EWD CLASSES

AQHA Rulebook and its instructions for Equestrians with Disabilities are applied (§481. Competitions for Rider with disabilities), stallions are not allowed in EWD-classes. The exhibitor must have a valid individual AQHA membership).
